Position Summary:

This position is responsible and accountable for providing leadership and specialized expertise in healthcare, health education, case management and counselling related to women's health as well as managing the coordination of approved community development initiatives and activities.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Maintain a strong knowledge base and skills to provide relevant support to clients and accurately assess client needs
- Participate in healthcare functions and counselling as required
- Assume full responsibility for a unique area and provide relevant and timely comprehensive health assessment and support
- Perform client care duties and functions as listed in the CRNM Competencies and Standards of Practice for Registered Nurses on Extended Practice Register.
- Communicate test results and pertinent information to clients and/or physicians as appropriate; make referrals to other agencies, physicians or caregivers as appropriate

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Proof of registration and certification with the College of Registered Nurses as an Extended Practice Nurse
- Minimum two years of experience in a community health setting
- Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS) certification
- Must be legally eligible to work in Canada
- Satisfactory Criminal Record check with vulnerable sector search, Child Abuse and Adult Abuse Registry check
